The Deputy Bailiff having this day placed before the Court a notification from the New Zealand High Commission, London dated 8th November, 2010 advising the Chief Minister of the States of Guernsey that New Zealand has completed its necessary internal procedures for entry into force of the Agreement between the States of Guernsey and the Government of New Zealand for the exchange of information with respect to taxes and the allocation of taxing rights with respect to certain income of individuals, signed in London on 21st July, 2009.

THE COURT, after the reading of the said notification and after having heard Her Majesty's Procureur thereon, ORDERED:-

1. That the said notification be registered on the records of this Island and
2. That an extract of this present Act, together with a copy of the said notification, be sent by Her Majesty's Greffier to the Greffier of the Court of Alderney for registration on the records of that Island.
