The Deputy Bailiff having this day placed before the Court a Note Verbale from the Embassy of the Federal Republic of Germany, London dated 18th November, 2010 advising the Policy Council of the States of Guernsey that the national requirements have been fulfilled for the entry into force of the Agreement between the Federal Republic of Germany and the States of Guernsey for the exchange of information relating to tax matters, dated 26th March, 2009.

THE COURT, after the reading of the said Note Verbale and after having heard Her Majesty's Procureur thereon, ORDERED:-

1. That the said Note Verbale be registered on the records of this Island and
2. That an extract of this present Act, together with a copy of the said Note Verbale, be sent by Her Majesty's Greffier to the Greffier of the Court of Alderney for registration on the records of that Island.
