The Deputy Bailiff having this day placed before the Court a letter dated 30th September, 2010 from the French Embassy, London advising the Lieutenant Governor of Guernsey of the completion of the internal procedures required by the French Constitution for entry into force of the Agreement between the Government of the French Republic and the States of Guernsey for the exchange of information relating to tax matters dated 24th March, 2009.

THE COURT, after the reading of the said letter and after having heard Her Majesty's Procureur thereon, ORDERED:-

1. That the said letter be registered on the records of this Island and
2. That an extract of this present Act, together with a copy of the said letter, be sent by Her Majesty's Greffier to the Greffier of the Court of Alderney for registration on the records of that Island.
