



In the Royal Court of the Island of Guernsey

The 11th day of July, 2000 before Andrew Christopher King Day, Esquire, Deputy Bailiff; present:- John Richard Rowe Henry, David Charles Lowe, Esquires, Mrs. Eileen May Glass, Laurence Lenfestey Guille, Derek Martin Le Page, Stephen Edward Francis Le Poidevin, Alan Cecil Bisson, Keith Bichard, OBE, Esquires, The Reverend Peter Gerald Lane, Michael John Wilson and Michael Henry De La Mare, Esquires, Jurats.

The Deputy Bailiff having this day placed before the Court an Issue of Special Ensign Privilege, whereby the Secretary of State for Defence warrants and authorises all vessels employed in the service of the States of Guernsey to wear the Blue Ensign defaced with the Cross of Guernsey, THE COURT, after having heard Her Majesty's Comptroller thereon, ORDERED:-

1. that the said be registered on the records of this Island; and
2. that an extract of this present Act, together with a copy of the said Issue of Special Ensign Privilege be sent by Her Majesty's Greffier to the Clerk of the Court of Alderney for registration on the records of that Island.

ISSUE OF SPECIAL ENSIGN PRIVILEGE

By virtue of the power vested in him under the provision of Section 2(3) of the Merchant Shipping Act 1995, and all other powers and authorities him thereunto enabling, the Secretary of State for Defence hereby warrants and authorises all vessels employed in the service of the States of Guernsey to wear the Blue Ensign defaced with the Cross of Guernsey in the fly thereof.

And to wear a small Blue Flag with a Union described in the canton at the upper corner thereof next to the staff, as a Jack, with the Cross of Guernsey in the fly thereof.

This Warrant shall be revocable at the discretion of the Secretary of State for Defence.
