EXCHANGE OF NOTES BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENT OF THE UNITED KINGDOM OF GREAT BRITAIN AND NORTHERN IRELAND AND THE GOVERNMENT OF THE KINGDOM OF SWAZILAND EXTENDING THE AGREEMENT FOR THE PROMOTION AND PROTECTION OF INVESTMENTS DONE AT LONDON ON 5 MAY 1995 TO THE ISLE OF MAN AND THE BAILIWICKS OF GUERNSEY AND JERSEY

The British High Commissioner at Mbabane to the Minister of Foreign Affairs and Trade of Swaziland

Your Excellency,

I have the honour to refer to the Agreement between the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and the Government of the Kingdom of Swaziland for the Promotion and Protection of Investments done at London on 5 May 1995¹ and, in accordance with the provisions of Article 12 thereof, to propose that the Agreement shall be extended to the Isle of Man, and the Bailiwicks of Guernsey and Jersey.

If this proposal is acceptable to the Government of the Kingdom of Swaziland, I have the honour to suggest that the present Note and Your Excellency's reply to that effect shall constitute an Agreement between the two Governments which shall enter into force on the date of your reply.

I avail myself of this opportunity to extend to Your Excellency the assurance of my highest consideration.
