The Bailiff having this day placed before the Court Agreements, in the form of exchanges of letters, on the Taxation of Savings Income and the Provisional Application Thereof, between Guernsey and each of the following countries: Austria, Belgium, Cyprus, Czech Republic, Denmark, Estonia, Finland, France, Germany, Greece, Hungary, Ireland, Italy, Latvia, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Malta, Netherlands, Poland, Portugal, Slovakia, Slovenia, Spain, Sweden and the United Kingdom, respectively, which were signed on behalf of Guernsey on 19th November, 2004, save for that with Spain which was signed on 17th February, 2005, THE COURT, after the reading of the said Agreements and after having heard Her Majesty's Procureur thereon, ORDERED:-

1. That the said Agreements be registered on the records of this Island and
2. That an extract of this present Act, together with a copy of the said Agreements, be sent by Her Majesty's Greffier to the Clerk of the Court of Alderney for registration on the records of that Island.
