**The Customs and Excise (Safety and Security)
(Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment) Regulations, 2024**

THE STATES COMMITTEE FOR HOME AFFAIRS, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by sections 14D and 79 of the Customs and Excise (General Provisions) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 1972^a and all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations:-

Amendment to the 2020 Regulations.

1. In regulation 26(4) of the Customs and Excise (Safety and Security) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Regulations, 2020^b, for "with effect from 31st October 2024" substitute "with effect from such date as may be specified by direction of the Chief Officer of Customs and Excise", and after regulation 26(4) insert –

"(5) A direction of the Chief Officer of Customs and Excise under paragraph (4) must be published on the States of Guernsey website."

Citation and commencement.

2. These Regulations may be cited as the Customs and Excise (Safety and Security) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment) Regulations, 2024, and shall come into force on being made.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations amend the Customs and Excise (Safety and Security) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Regulations, 2020 to provide that Part I (Imports), as it applies in respect of goods imported directly into the Bailiwick from the European Union, will come into force on a date specified in a direction made by the Chief Officer of Customs and Excise, and that such direction must be published on the States of Guernsey website. The commencement of Part I as it applies to such goods has been deferred by way of amending regulations on several occasions to tie in with the planned commencement of the equivalent United Kingdom provisions, and this change removes the need for further amending regulations in this regard while ensuring transparency regarding the relevant date.

These Regulations came into force on being made.
