**The Court of Appeal (Civil Division)
(Costs and Fees) (Guernsey) (Amendment) Rules, 2024**

THE BAILIFF OF GUERNSEY, in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by sections 18(2) and 44 of the Court of Appeal (Guernsey) Law, 1961^a, and all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby orders:-

Amendment of Principal Rules.

1. The Court of Appeal (Civil Division) (Costs and Fees) (Guernsey) Rules, 2012^b ("the Principal Rules") are amended as follows.

2. In Rule 3 of the Principal Rules –

(a) in paragraph (2), for "£325" substitute "£340", and

(b) in paragraph (3), for "2025" substitute "2026".

3. For the Schedule to the Principal Rules, substitute the Schedule set out in the Schedule to these Rules.

Repeals.

4. The following enactments are repealed –
- (a) the Court of Appeal (Civil Division) (Costs and Fees) (Guernsey) (Amendment) Rules, 2015^c,
 - (b) the Court of Appeal (Civil Division) (Costs and Fees) (Guernsey) (Amendment) Rules, 2016^d,
 - (c) the Court of Appeal (Civil Division) (Costs and Fees) (Guernsey) (Amendment) Rules, 2018^e, and
 - (d) the Court of Appeal (Civil Division) (Costs and Fees) (Guernsey) (Amendment) Rules, 2023^f.

Transitional provisions.

5. These Rules shall have effect in relation to Court Fees, Advocates' fees and other recoverable costs incurred (whether before, on or after the date of commencement specified in Rule 7) –

- (a) in respect of any appeal commenced, but not finally determined or disposed of, before that date, and

- (b) in respect of any appeal commenced on or after that date,

and for the purposes of this Rule an appeal shall be considered to have commenced when a notice of appeal or application preliminary to an appeal is delivered to the Registrar.

Citation.

6. These Rules may be cited as the Court of Appeal (Civil Division) (Costs and Fees) (Guernsey) (Amendment) Rules, 2024.

Commencement.

7. These Rules shall come into force on the 1st January, 2025.

Court: In the event that the hearing or application does not take place for whatever reason, the Court retains discretion to charge for actual non recoverable travel and accommodation costs incurred and all incidental and ancillary costs relating thereto.
5. Hearing of applications to Court (where three judges are sitting), including determination of an application on the papers.	Court: £1158 per hour or part thereof, provided however that a reduced fee of £579 shall be payable if a hearing takes less than 30 minutes in total.
6. Hearing of applications to single judge or to presiding judge of court below, including determination of an application on the papers.	Court: £395 per hour or part thereof.
7. Hearing of appeal.	Court: £1158 per hour or part thereof.
