**The Medicines (Modification of Conditions of  
Corporate Pharmacy Business) (Bailiwick of Guernsey)  
Regulations, 2024**

**THE COMMITTEE FOR HEALTH & SOCIAL CARE**, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by sections 54 and 132 of the Medicines (Human and Veterinary) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 2008<sup>a</sup> and all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations:-

**Variation of section 51 of the Law.**

1. (1) Section 51 (business carried on by body corporate) of the Law is varied (and consequentially amended) as follows.

(2) In subsection (2)(a) of that section, for "resident in the Bailiwick," substitute "registered as a recognised pharmacist in the register of pharmacists maintained under section 2 of the Doctors, Dentists and Pharmacists Ordinance, 1987, and -

- (i) either the superintendent is resident in the Bailiwick, or
- (ii) the condition in subsection (3) is satisfied,".

(3) Immediately after subsection (2) of that section, insert the following subsection -

"(3) The condition in this subsection is satisfied if -

- (a) the Chief Pharmacist is satisfied that the body corporate carrying on the retail pharmacy business has an appropriate governance structure in place to ensure that that business is carried on to an appropriate standard despite the superintendent not being resident in the Bailiwick, and
- (b) not more than 18 months before any given time during which the superintendent is not resident in the Bailiwick, the Chief Pharmacist has given the body corporate written confirmation that the Chief Pharmacist is so satisfied."

**Modification of effect of section 47(1) of the Law.**

2. For the avoidance of doubt, section 47(1)(b) (general provisions) of the Law has effect subject to the variation of section 51 of the Law by regulation 1.

**Interpretation.**

3. In these Regulations, "**the Law**" means the Medicines (Human and Veterinary) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 2008.

**Citation.**

4. These Regulations may be cited as the Medicines (Modification of Conditions of Corporate Pharmacy Business) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Regulations, 2024.

**Commencement.**

5. These Regulations shall come into force on the 1<sup>st</sup> January, 2025.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This note is not part of the Regulations)*

These Regulations amend the conditions applying to a body corporate carrying on a retail pharmacy business, by modifying the provisions of section 51 of the Medicines

(Human and Veterinary) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 2008 relating to the superintendent pharmacist.

These Regulations will come into force on the 1<sup>st</sup> January, 2025.
