THE COMMITTEE FOR ENVIRONMENT & INFRASTRUCTURE, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section 1 of the Traffic Temporary Regulations Ordinance, 1950^a, and all other powers enabling it in that behalf, and in order to ascertain the best method of regulating traffic in the locality referred to in these Regulations, hereby makes the following Regulations:-

Prohibition relating to certain vehicles on Rue de l'Arquet.

1. (1) Subject to paragraph (2), a person in charge of a power-driven vehicle shall not drive or ride that vehicle at a prohibited time on or along Rue de l'Arquet.

(2) Paragraph (1) does not apply to –

- (a) any vehicle being used for ambulance, fire brigade or police purposes in an emergency,
- (b) vehicles travelling to or from premises located on Rue de l'Arquet,

- (c) anything done with the written permission of the Committee, provided that any conditions or requirements it imposes are complied with, or
- (d) anything done with the permission of, or at the direction of, a police officer.

(3) A "**prohibited time**" in this regulation means, on a school day, a time falling between –

- (a) 08:00 and 09:00, or
- (b) 14:30 and 15:30.

Interpretation.

2. In these Regulations –

"**the Committee**" means the Committee for the Environment and Infrastructure,

"**police officer**" means –

- (a) a member of the salaried police force of the Island of Guernsey and,
- (b) within the limits of the member's jurisdiction, a member of the special constabulary of the Island of Guernsey,

"**power-driven vehicle**" has the same meaning as that in the Traffic Signs and Traffic Light Signals Ordinance, 1988^b, and

"**school day**" means any day on which La Hougette Primary School is open to pupils in accordance with the determinations of the Committee for Education, Sport & Culture under section 8 of the Education (Guernsey) Law, 1970^c, or in accordance with any similar power under any other enactment.

Extent.

3. These Regulations shall have effect in the Island of Guernsey.

Citation.

4. These Regulations may be cited as the Traffic Temporary (Rue de l'Arquet) Regulations, 2024.

Commencement.

5. These Regulations shall come into force on the 20th January, 2025 and cease to have effect –

- (a) at the end of the period of 12 months commencing with that date, or
- (b) on any earlier date determined by further regulations made by the Committee.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

These Regulations make provision for the introduction, for an experimental period of up to 12 months, of a prohibition on driving a power-driven vehicle on Rue de l'Arquet during specified times. The purpose is to ascertain the best method of regulating traffic in close proximity to La Houquette Primary School on school days, at times when pupils typically arrive at or leave the school, with a view to ensuring the safety of pedestrians and cyclists and encouraging the adoption of active transportation methods.

Between the specified times the prohibition will apply to all power-driven vehicles, other than emergency vehicles, unless the motorist is travelling to or from premises located on Rue de l'Arquet or is acting in accordance with written permission from the Committee or at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police officer.
