The Fees (Alderney) Ordinance, 2024

THE STATES OF ALDERNEY, in pursuance of their Resolution of the 18th December 2024, and in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 2(3) of the Tourist (Alderney) Law, 1956^a, sections 1(2) and 8(3) of the Nursing and Residential Homes (Registration and Occupation) (Alderney) Law, 1987^b, sections 2(8) and 25 of the Water (Control) (Alderney) Law, 1994^c, and sections 1 and 6 of the Fees (Alderney) Law, 2011^d and all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby order:-

Miscellaneous fees prescribed in accordance with the Fees Law.

1. The fees set out in third column of Part I of Schedule 1 are prescribed in accordance with the Fees Law, for the purposes set out in the corresponding row of the second column of Schedule 1 as provided for in the enactment set out in the corresponding row in the first column of Schedule 1.

Motor vehicle import licence fees prescribed in accordance with the Fees Law.

2. (1) The motor vehicle import fees set out in the fourth and fifth columns of Part II of Schedule 1 are prescribed in accordance with the Fees Law, for –

- (a) the purposes set out in the corresponding row of the second column of Part II of Schedule 1, and
- (b) the weight of vehicle set out in the corresponding row

of the third column of Part II of Schedule 1,

as provided for in the Import and Export (Control) Alderney, Law, 1946 referred to in the corresponding row in the first column of Part II of Schedule 1.

(2) The Chief Executive of the States, acting as Clerk of the States, may require a person importing a vehicle for commercial use to provide a declaration as to the intended end use of the vehicle in such form and manner as the Chief Executive may provide; and in this subsection “commercial use” shall be construed in accordance with paragraph 2(3) of Part III of Schedule 1.

Reimbursement of motor vehicle import fees prescribed under section 2.

3. Where the Chief Executive of the States, acting as Clerk of the States, is satisfied that a motor vehicle has been permanently exported from the island, the Chief Executive must reimburse to the person who paid the fee -

- (a) where the vehicle is exported within 28 days starting from the date it was imported into the island, 100% of the fee prescribed under section 2 minus an administration charge of £40, and
- (b) where the vehicle is exported within 2 years starting from the date it was imported into the island, 50% of the fee prescribed under section 2.

Fees prescribed under other enactments.

4. The fees set out in third column of Schedule 2 are prescribed under the relevant enactment set out in the corresponding row in the first column of Schedule 2, for the purpose set out in the corresponding row of the second column of Schedule 2.

Interpretation.

5. In this Ordinance, unless the context requires otherwise -

"**Clerk of the States**" is construed in accordance with section 52(5) of the Government of Alderney Law, 2004^e,

"**Fees Law**" means the Fees (Alderney) Law, 2011, and

"**States**" means the States of Alderney.

Consequential repeals.

6. The Fees (Alderney) Ordinance, 2018^f is repealed.

Citation and commencement.

7. This Ordinance may be cited as the Fees (Alderney) Ordinance, 2024 and shall come into force on the 1st January, 2025.

PART III

INTERPRETATION

Interpretation of Part I of Schedule 1.

1. (1) In Part I of this Schedule, unless the context requires otherwise, "**renewal**" means an application made to renew a licence, permit, certificate, registration or other consent ("**relevant consent**") referred to in that Part immediately upon the expiry of the previous relevant consent.

(2) In Part I of this Schedule –

(a) terms and expressions used in the second column of the Table, which are not otherwise defined in this Ordinance, have the same meaning as in the enactments cited in the corresponding row of the first column of that Table, and

(b) references to articles, sections or Parts in the second column of the Table are to articles, sections or Parts, as the case may be, of the enactment cited in the corresponding row of the first column of the Table.

Interpretation of Part II of Schedule 1.

2. (1) In Part II of this Schedule -

"**business**" includes any economic activity, trade or profession, whether or not carried on for profit,

"**Committee**" means the States Policy and Finance Committee, and

"**registration book**" shall be construed in accordance with section 7(1) of the Ordonnance supplémentaire à l'Ordonnance ayant rapport au Trafic Véhiculaire en cette Ileⁿ as applied to Alderney, and

"**unladen weight**" means -

- (a) the unladen weight described in the particulars appearing in the registration book relating to the vehicle, or
- (b) in a case where there is no registration book, such weight as the Committee may reasonably determine in relation to the vehicle.

(2) In Part II of this Schedule, a reference to a category of driving licence is to be construed as a reference to the relevant category of the same description set out in Schedule 4 to the Driving Licences (Guernsey) Ordinance, 1995^o.

(3) For the purposes of Part II of this Schedule, a vehicle is

imported for commercial use if it is imported for an end use in the course of a business and, for the avoidance of doubt, a vehicle is not imported for such use if it is imported for commercial sale to an end user for use other than in the course of a business.

(4) For the purposes of Part II of this Schedule, a vehicle is imported for non-commercial use if the intended end use is other than in the course of a business.
