**The Prohibited and One-Way Streets (Amendment)
Order, 2025**

18th February, 2025

Coming into operation

10th March, 2025

THE COMMITTEE FOR THE ENVIRONMENT & INFRASTRUCTURE, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 3A(1) of the Prohibited and One-Way Streets Ordinance, 1989^a, and all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby orders:-

Amendment to 1989 Ordinance.

1. (1) The Prohibited and One-Way Streets Ordinance, 1989 is amended so that, immediately after paragraph 1 of Part X of Schedule 1, the following paragraph is inserted -

"2. Ruelle de la Tourelle: this paragraph does not apply to -

- (a) cycles,
- (b) electrically assisted pedal cycles (within the meaning of section 3 of the Motor Vehicles

(Electrically Assisted Pedal Cycles)
(Exemption) (Guernsey) Law, 2002), or

(c) animals, other than those drawing vehicles.".

Repeal.

2. The Traffic Temporary (Ruelle de la Tourelle) Regulations, 2024^b are hereby repealed.

Citation.

3. This Order may be cited as the Prohibited and One-Way Streets (Amendment) Order, 2025.

Commencement.

4. This Order shall come into force on 10th March, 2025.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order makes permanent the temporary traffic experiment introduced under the Traffic Temporary (Ruelle de la Tourelle) Regulations, 2024. It does so by amending the Prohibited and One-Way Streets Ordinance, 1989 so as to prohibit vehicles from using Ruelle de la Tourelle. As with the temporary traffic experiment, this prohibition does not apply to cycles, electrically assisted pedal cycles, or animals other than those drawing vehicles.

This Order comes into force on 10th March, 2025
