**The Ro-Ro Sea-links (Concession Licence for Brittany
Ferries and Authorisation to Assign) (Guernsey) Order,
2025**

25th March, 2025

Coming into operation

1st April, 2025

THE COMMITTEE FOR ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by sections 3 and 8 of the Ro-Ro Sea-links (Guernsey) Law, 2024^a, and all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby orders:-

Grant of concession licence to Brittany Ferries.

1. (1) The Committee grants a concession licence ("**the Licence**") to Brittany Ferries subject to the Concession Agreement.

(2) The Licence is valid for the period beginning the 1st April, 2025 and ending the 31st March, 2040, inclusive of both dates, but if the Concession

Agreement is renewed for a further five years, the Committee may renew the Licence for that further period.

(3) For the avoidance of doubt, the Licence may be suspended or revoked in accordance with the Ro-Ro Sea-links (Guernsey) Law, 2024.

Assignment of concession licence to Condor Limited.

2. (1) Subject to paragraph (2), the Committee authorises Brittany Ferries' assignment of the Licence to Condor Limited under the Concession Agreement.

(2) This assignment is subject to the Concession Agreement, and in particular to the reversion of the Licence to Brittany Ferries where provided for under the Agreement.

Interpretation.

3. In this Order –

"**Brittany Ferries**" means **BAI Bretagne Angleterre Irlande S.A.**, Société à Directoire et Conseil de Surveillance, incorporated and registered in France with company number R.C.S. Brest 927 250 217, whose registered office for the time being is at port du Bloscon - CS 60072 - 29688 Roscoff cedex, France,

"**the Committee**" means the Committee for Economic Development,

"**the Concession Agreement**" means the Guernsey Ferry Concession Agreement entered into between the States of Guernsey, Brittany Ferries and Condor Limited on the 4th December, 2024, and

"**Condor Limited**" means Condor Limited, incorporated and registered in Guernsey with registration number [CMP738], whose registered office for the time being is at New Jetty Offices, White Rock, St Peter Port, GY1 2LL, Guernsey.

Citation.

4. This Order may be cited as the Ro-Ro Sea-links (Concession Licence for Brittany Ferries and Authorisation to Assign) (Guernsey) Order, 2025.

Commencement.

5. This Order shall come into force on the 1st April, 2025.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order grants a concession licence under the Ro-Ro Sea-links (Guernsey) Law, 2024 to Brittany Ferries from the 1st April, 2025 to the 31st March, 2040 inclusive of both dates.

The licence is subject to the Guernsey Ferry Concession Agreement concluded between the States of Guernsey, Brittany Ferries and Condor Limited. The licence may be renewed for a further five years, and may be suspended or revoked in accordance with that Law.

Further, this Order authorises Brittany Ferries to assign the licence to Condor Limited under and subject to the Concession Agreement.

This Order (and the Law itself) comes into force on the 1st April, 2025.
