**The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying)  
(Bailiwick of Guernsey) Regulations, 2024**

**THE DIRECTOR OF CIVIL AVIATION**, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 35(1)(a) and (c) of the Air Navigation (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 2012<sup>a</sup> and all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations: -

**Restriction of flying over St Peter Port Guernsey.**

1. (1) No UAS including Drones shall, from 0800 hours (UTC) on 9<sup>th</sup> May 2025 until 2359 hours (UTC) on 9<sup>th</sup> May 2025, fly into the airspace having lateral limits of a circle radius of 1.5 nautical miles centered on Guernsey Harbour Signal Station, Peter Port, Guernsey (N 49°27'22.4'' – W 2°31'35.3'') and vertical limits of the surface to 500' or take off from any place in that area except those mentioned in regulation 1(2).

- (2) Paragraph (1) shall not apply to -
- (a) any drone flying with the permission of the Head of Air Navigation Services, Guernsey,
  - (b) any drone flying with the permission (Exemption) from the Director of Civil Aviation.
  - (c) any drone flying with the permission of the Guernsey Law enforcement, or

- (d) any drone flying for the purpose of Search and Rescue or for the purpose of saving life.


**Interpretation.**

4. All times referred to in these Regulations are Universal Time Coordinated (UTC).

**Citation and commencement.**

5. These Regulations may be cited as the Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Regulations, 2024 and shall come into force on 9<sup>th</sup> May 2025.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations prohibit (subject to the granting of exemptions) all UAS including Drones within a 1.5 nautical miles radius and from the surface to 500' of position:

N 49° 27'22.4''

W 2°31'35.3''

between 0800 hours (UTC) on the 9<sup>th</sup> May 2025 and 2359 hours (UTC) on the 9<sup>th</sup> May 2025 by reason of Liberation Day celebrations.
