**The Animal Welfare (Designation and Control of Pest
Animals) (Amendment) Order, 2025**

THE COMMITTEE FOR THE ENVIRONMENT & INFRASTRUCTURE, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by sections 14 of 79 of the Animal Welfare (Guernsey) Ordinance, 2012^a, and all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby orders:-

Amendment of the Order of 2014.

1. The Animal Welfare (Designation and Control of Pest Animals) Order, 2014^b ("the principal Order") is amended as follows.

Amendment of article 3 of the principal Order.

2. In article 3(1) of the principal Order, in the definition of "approved rodenticide", for "Control of Poisonous Substances Regulations, 1995", substitute "Control of Poisonous Substances (Guernsey) Regulations, 2014".

Amendment of Schedule 2 to the principal Order.

3. (1) Schedule 2 to the principal Order is amended as follows.

(2) Immediately after paragraph 3 of that schedule, insert the following paragraph –

"4. Paragraph 2(c) does not authorise any person to set, or permit the setting of, a glue trap for a purpose or in a manner falling within section 12G(1) of the Animal Welfare (Guernsey) Ordinance, 2012, except under and in accordance with the terms and conditions of a licence issued by the Committee under section 12G(2) of that Ordinance."

(3) In the table in Part II of that schedule –

(a) delete the entries relating to the following traps –

(i) Fenn Vermin Trap Mark I,

(ii) Fenn Vermin Trap Mark TI,

(iii) Fenn Vermin Trap Mark III,

(iv) Imbra Trap Mark I,

(v) Imbra Trap Mark II,

- (vii) Lloyd Trap,
- (viii) Sawyer Trap,
- (ix) Wise Trap 110,
- (x) Wise Trap 160,
- (xi) Wise Trap 200,
- (xii) Wise Trap 250, and

(b) insert the following entries in the correct alphabetical order –

<p>Quill Trap manufactured by or under the authority of Quill Productions, Manor Farm, Pulham, Dorchester, Dorset, DT2 7EE.</p>	<p>The trap may be used only for the purpose of killing rats.</p> <p>Where used in a closed-end trap configuration, the trap must be set in an artificial tunnel constructed to the design specified by Quill Productions using materials suitable for the purpose.</p> <p>Where used in a run-through trap configuration, the trap must be set in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions for the run-through configuration in a</p>

	natural or artificial tunnel which is, in either case, suitable for the purpose.

4. This Order may be cited as the Animal Welfare (Designation and Control of Pest Animals) (Amendment) Order, 2025.

Commencement.

5. (1) Subject to paragraph (2), this Order shall come into force on the 1st May, 2025.

(2) Article 3(3)(a) of this Order shall come into force on the 1st August, 2025.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order amends the Animal Welfare (Designation and Control of Pest Animals) Order, 2014 ("**the principal Order**").

It replaces a reference to the revoked Control of Poisonous Substances Regulations, 1995 with a reference to the current Control of Poisonous Substances (Guernsey) Regulations, 2014.

It amends the list of spring traps that can be used to control rats and mice in Part II of the Schedule 2 to the principal Order.

Finally, it amends a paragraph in Schedule 2 to the principal Order which authorises devices which trap rats and mice alive to clarify that that paragraph does not authorise any person to set a glue trap, which would otherwise be prohibited under the Animal Welfare (Guernsey) Ordinance, 2012, as amended by the Animal Welfare (Guernsey)

(Amendment) Ordinance, 2025, except where a licence is issued by the Committee for the Environment & Infrastructure.

Other than article 3(3)(a), this Order comes into force on the 1st May, 2025. Article 3(3)(a), which deletes traps in the table in Part II of Schedule 2 to the principal Order, will come into force on the 1st August, 2025.
