**The Vaping Products (Acceptable Documents to
Establish Age) (Guernsey) Regulations, 2025**

THE COMMITTEE FOR HEALTH & SOCIAL CARE, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section 47(2)(a) of the Vaping Products (Guernsey) Ordinance, 2025^a, and all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations:-

Acceptable documents for establishing a person's age.

1. The following kinds of documents are prescribed for the purposes of section 47(2)(a) of the Vaping Products (Guernsey) Ordinance, 2025 –

- (a) a passport or photographic driving licence issued by the competent authority of any country or territory,

- (b) a CitizenCard proof of identity and age card issued by CitizenCard Limited or an equivalent person in the United Kingdom.

Citation.

2. These Regulations may be cited as the Vaping Products (Acceptable Documents to Establish Age) (Guernsey) Regulations, 2025.

Commencement.

3. These Regulations shall come into force on the 1st June, 2025.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations prescribe passports, photographic driving licences and UK-issued CitizenCards as the only kinds of documents that would be regarded as acceptable to establish the age of a person for the purposes of section 47(2)(a) of the Vaping Products (Guernsey) Ordinance, 2025. In particular, these documents can be used to establish the age of a person for the purposes of the prohibition of the sale or supply of vaping products to children under section 25 of that Ordinance.

These Regulations will come into force on the 1st June, 2025.
