**The Plant Health (Preserved Phytosanitary Conditions  
Regulation) (Amendment) (Guernsey) Regulations, 2025**

THE COMMITTEE FOR ENVIRONMENT & INFRASTRUCTURE, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Article 108 of Preserved Regulation (EU) 2016/2031 of the European Parliament and of the Council on protective measures against pests of plants<sup>a</sup> and all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following regulations:-

**Amendments to the Preserved Phytosanitary Conditions Regulation.**

1. (1) The Preserved Phytosanitary Conditions Regulation is amended, insofar as it applies to Guernsey, as follows.

(2) In Annex 2 (list of Guernsey quarantine pests), in the table in Part A (pests not known to occur in Guernsey) –

- (a) under the heading "**A. Bacteria**", after entry 3, insert "3A. *Pseudomonas avellanae* Janse et al. [PSDMAL]",
- (b) under the heading "**C. Insects and mites**", after entry 80, insert "80A. *Neodiprion abietis* (Harris) [NEODAB], and
- (c) under the heading "**F. Viruses, viroids and phytoplasmas**", delete entry 24.

(3) In Annex 2A (list of provisional Guernsey quarantine pests), in the table (provisional Guernsey quarantine pests and their EPPO codes) –

- (a) under the heading "**B. Insects and mites**", delete entry 6A, and
- (b) under the heading "**D. Bacteria**", delete entry 2.

(4) In Annex 4 (list of Guernsey regulated non-quarantine pests and their respective plants for planting) –

- (a) in the table in Part B (RNQPs concerning vine propagating material), under the heading "**Viruses, viroids, virus-like diseases and phytoplasmas**", at the end insert -

- (j) in entry 127, in the first column, for "*Fraxinus* L., *Juglans ailantifolia* Carr., *Juglans mandshurica* Maxim., *Ulmus davidiana* Planch. and *Pterocarya rhoifolia* Siebold & Zucc.", substitute "*Chionanthus virginicus* L., *Fraxinus* L. and *Ulmus davidiana* Planchon".

(7) In Annex 11 (list of plants, plant products and other objects and the respective third countries of origin or dispatch in respect of which phytosanitary certificates are required), in the table in Part A (List of plants, plant products and other objects and the respective third countries of origin or dispatch, which may not be

introduced into Guernsey unless they are accompanied by a phytosanitary certificate, as referred to in Article 72(1) of Regulation (EU) 2016/2031) –

**Interpretation.**

2. In these Regulations, unless the context requires otherwise –

**"the Preserved Phytosanitary Conditions Regulation"** means the item of Preserved EU law entitled Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) 2019/2072 establishing uniform conditions for the implementation of Regulation (EU) 2016/2031 of the European Parliament and the Council, as regards protective measures against pests of plants.

**Extent.**

3. These Regulations shall have effect in the Islands of Guernsey, Herm and Jethou.

**Citation.**


4. These Regulations may be cited as the Plant Health (Preserved Phytosanitary Conditions Regulation) (Amendment) (Guernsey) Regulations. 2025.

**Commencement.**

5. (1) These Regulations shall, subject to paragraph (2), come into force on 30<sup>th</sup> May. 2025.

(2) Regulations 1(6)(c) and (d) and 1(7)(a) shall come into force on 8<sup>th</sup> November, 2025.

**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

*(This note is not part of the Regulations)*

These Regulations make further amendments to the Preserved Phytosanitary Conditions Regulation which has effect in Guernsey as preserved EU law.

The amendments are made to align with amendments made in Great Britain as, from the end of 2020, Guernsey has been part of a Great Britain and Crown Dependency market in plants and plant products.

Regulation 1(2) adds *Pseudomonas avellanae* [PSDMAL] and *Neodiprion abietis* [NEODAB] to the list of Guernsey quarantine pests in Annex 2 and removes Tobacco ringspot virus [TRSV00].

Regulation 1(3) removes the two pests (which are added to Annex 2 by regulation 1(2)) from the list of provisional Guernsey quarantine pests in Annex 2A.

Regulation 1(4) adds Tobacco ringspot virus [TRSV00] to the list of Guernsey regulated non-quarantine pests in Annex 4 and amends host plants and the thresholds for the presence of pests.

Regulation 1(5) removes Tomato ringspot virus [TORSV0] from Annex 5 in respect of measures relating to regulated non-quarantine pests on specific plants for planting.

Regulation 1(6) amends Annex 7 to clarify import requirements of existing entries, make new provision for *Pseudomonas avellanae*, remove an import requirement relating to treatment for cut flowers and to revise the commodities regulated as hosts of *Agrilus planipennis*.

Regulation 1(7) updates Part A of Annex 11 to align the list of plants, plant products and other objects and the respective third countries of origin or dispatch in respect of which phytosanitary certificates are required, with the requirements set out in Annex 7.

Regulations 1(6)(c) and (d) and 1(7)(a) change references to “Pinales” to “Pinopsida” in Annexes 7 and 11 to ensure consistency with the internationally recognised name for conifers.

These Regulations come into force on 30<sup>th</sup> May, 2025 except for the above amendments relating to the references to “Pinales” which come into force on 8<sup>th</sup> November, 2025.
