**The Import (Control) (Guernsey) (Amendment)
(No. 4) Order, 2025**

Made 27th May, 2025

Coming into operation 28th May, 2025

THE COMMITTEE FOR HOME AFFAIRS, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by article 1 of the Import and Export (Control) (Guernsey) Law, 1946^a and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following order:-

Amendment of the Import (Control) (Guernsey) Order, 2010.

1. (1) Schedule 10 to the Import (Control) (Guernsey) Order, 2010^b is amended as follows.

(2) In the table in that schedule-

- (a) in entry no. 3, in column 2, for "Germany, Hungary, Austria or Slovakia", substitute "Austria, Hungary or Slovakia, except where, and to the extent that, any of these countries have been declared to be free of foot and mouth disease by the Department for Environment, Food & Rural Affairs of the United Kingdom", and

(b) in entry nos. 4 and 5, in column 2 in each case, for ", Slovakia or FMD restricted zones in Germany" in each place where the expression occurs, substitute "or Slovakia, except where, and to the extent that, any of these countries have been declared to be free of foot and mouth disease by the Department for Environment, Food & Rural Affairs of the United Kingdom".

(3) In the part of the schedule headed "**General interpretation**", delete the definition of "**FMD restricted zones in Germany**".

Citation.

2. This Order may be cited as the Import (Control) (Guernsey) (Amendment) (No. 4) Order, 2025.

Commencement.

3. This Order shall come into force on the 28th May, 2025.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order amends Schedule 10 to the Import (Control) (Guernsey) Order, 2010 to remove Germany, and zones in it, from the areas of origin from which certain imports are prohibited. It further provides that Austria, Hungary or Slovakia, or any area within these countries, ceases to be an area of origin from which those imports are prohibited, if the Department for Environment, Food & Rural Affairs of the United Kingdom (DEFRA) declares that the relevant country (or area) is free of foot-and-mouth disease.

This Order comes into force on the 28th May, 2025.
