**The Immigration (Bailiwick of Guernsey)
(Amendment) (No. 2) Rules, 2025**

THE COMMITTEE FOR HOME AFFAIRS, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 3(2) of the Immigration Act 1971^a as extended to the Bailiwick of Guernsey by the Immigration (Guernsey) Order, 1993^b, and all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following rules:-

Amendment to Rules of 2008.

1. (1) The Immigration (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Rules 2008^c ("the principal Rules") are amended as follows.

(2) In paragraph 11A(i)(iii) of the principal Rules, for "30th September, 2024", substitute "the 31st December, 2025".

2. For the avoidance of doubt, unless the context requires otherwise, an expression used in these Rules has the same meaning as in the Immigration Act 1971 (as extended to the Bailiwick of Guernsey).

3. These Rules may be cited as the Immigration (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment) (No. 2) Rules, 2025.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

These Rules amend the Immigration (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Rules, 2008 ("**the principal Rules**") to provide for French ID cards to continue to be accepted as proof of identity and nationality for day-trippers.

These Rules will come into force on the day on which they are made (the 29th July, 2025).
