**The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Air Display)
(Bailiwick of Guernsey) Regulations, 2025**

THE DIRECTOR OF CIVIL AVIATION, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 35(1)(b) of the Air Navigation (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 2012^a and all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations: -

Restriction of flying and access to Guernsey Airport.

1. Guernsey Airport shall be closed from 17:30 until 19:00 hours (UTC) on 10th September 2025 to all aircraft except those mentioned in regulation 3(2).

2. Access to Guernsey Airport shall be by Prior Permission Required (PPR) to all aircraft except to scheduled services and to locally based aircraft on 10th September 2025.

3. (1) Subject to paragraph (2), no aircraft shall, from 17:30 until 19:00 hours (UTC) on 10th September 2025, fly into the airspace having lateral limits of a circle radius of 6 nautical miles centred on St Peter Port, Guernsey (N 49 27.350' W 002 31.270') and vertical limits of the surface to Flight Level 100 or take off from any place in that area.

- (2) Paragraph (1) shall not apply to -
- (a) any aircraft flying with the permission of the Head of Air Navigation Services, Guernsey,
 - (b) any aircraft flying with the permission of the Guernsey Air Display Flying Display Director, or
 - (c) any aircraft flying for the purpose of Search and Rescue or for the purpose of saving life.

Interpretation.

4. All times referred to in these Regulations are Universal Time Coordinated (UTC).

Citation and commencement.

5. These Regulations may be cited as the Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Air Display) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Regulations, 2025 and shall come into force on 10th September 2025.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations prohibit (subject to the granting of exemptions) all flights within a six nautical miles radius of position:

N 49 27.350'

W 002 31.270'

between 17:30 and 19:00 hours (UTC) on the 10th September, 2025 by reason of an air display. They impose other restrictions on flying and the use of Guernsey Airport in order to enable the display to be undertaken safely.
