**The Plant Health (Amendment of Transitional
Provision) (Guernsey) Regulations, 2025**

THE COMMITTEE FOR THE ENVIRONMENT & INFRASTRUCTURE, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by Article 108 of Preserved Regulation (EU) 2016/2031 of the European Parliament and of the Council on protective measures against pests of plants^a, and all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations:-

Amendment of the 2020 Regulations.

1. (1) The Plant Health (Brexit) (Guernsey) Regulations, 2020^b are amended as follows.

(2) In regulation 6 (transitional provision: plants, plant products and other objects from EU Member states), in paragraph 1(b) for "1st July, 2025" substitute "31st January, 2027".

Extent.

2. These Regulations shall have effect in the Islands of Guernsey, Herm and Jethou.

Citation.

3. These Regulations may be cited as the Plant Health (Amendment of Transitional Provision) (Guernsey) Regulations, 2025.

Commencement.

4. These Regulations shall come into force on the 3rd September, 2025.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations amend the transitional provision in regulation 6 of the Plant Health (Brexite) (Amendment) (Guernsey) Regulations, 2020, which makes transitional provision in relation to phytosanitary certificates to accompany certain plants and

plant products imported into Guernsey from EU Member States, Switzerland or Liechtenstein. The provision extends the transitional provision relating to plants etc. from the EU, Switzerland or Liechtenstein to 31st January 2027. This is consistent with an extension made to the equivalent transitional provision in Great Britain.

These Regulations come into force on 3rd September, 2025.
