Immigration (Port Facilities) (Bailiwick of Guernsey)

Coming into operation

THE COMMITTEE FOR HOME AFFAIRS, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by sections 25 and 166(3) of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999^a as extended to the Bailiwick^b, hereby orders:-

Facilities etc. that may be directed to be provided.

1. (1) The Schedule describes the accommodation, facilities, equipment and services that the Committee or a person authorised by the Committee may direct a port manager to provide for, or in connection with, the operation of immigration control at a control port under section 25 of the 1999 Act.

(2) Any senior immigration officer is authorised to give directions for the purposes of paragraph (1) of this article and section 25(1) of the 1999 Act.

Interpretation.

2. In this Order -

"**the 1971 Act**" means the Immigration Act 1971^c as extended to the Bailiwick,

"**the 1999 Act**" means the Immigration Act 1999 as extended to the Bailiwick,

"**the Committee**" means the Committee for Home Affairs,

"**control port**" means a port in which a control area is designated under paragraph 26(3) of Schedule 2 to the 1971 Act,

"**port manager**" means a person responsible for the management of a control port, and

"**senior immigration officer**" means an immigration officer whose duties include the supervision or management of other immigration officers.

Citation.

3. This Order may be cited as the Immigration (Port Facilities) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 2025.

Commencement.

4. This Order shall come into force on the 19th September, 2025.

SCHEDULE

Article 1(1)

ACCOMMODATION, FACILITIES, EQUIPMENT AND SERVICES THAT THE COMMITTEE MAY DIRECT TO BE PROVIDED

Accommodation, Facilities, Equipment and Services

1. Port managers must provide -

- (a) the specified accommodation, and
- (b) any facility, equipment, or service, in or at the specified accommodation,

as directed by a senior immigration officer to enable or facilitate immigration officers to carry out their functions in connection with immigration control.

2. These facilities, equipment and services include amenities specified in paragraph 4, which must be -

- (a) clean and clear of waste,
- (b) illuminated, ventilated and maintained at an adequate temperature, and
- (c) in a state of repair reflecting fair use.

3. These facilities, equipment and services must be -

- (a) suitable for each specified accommodation, and function or task (if any) directed by a senior immigration officer, and
- (b) adequate in terms of scale, security and privacy for the proper conduct of the formalities and controls carried out by the immigration officers.

4. The amenities referred to in paragraph 2 are as follows -
- (a) office accommodation, which includes provision for telephony and internet access,
 - (b) parking areas for vehicles under the control of officers as part of their duties,
 - (c) lavatory, shower and changing facilities,
 - (d) kitchen accommodation that is furnished and has a refrigerator and plumbed sink,
 - (e) space to examine persons (and, if required, things) properly, both without and with any specialised equipment under the control of those officers in the course of their duties,
 - (f) space to examine vehicles properly, both without and with any specialised equipment under the control of those officers in the course of their duties,
 - (g) space to store for up to two weeks all things that are subject to investigation by those officers in the course of their duties, and
 - (h) space and general equipment for the officers to properly carry out their functions under the 1971 Act and any other enactment relating to immigration.
5. The following must also be provided if directed by a senior immigration officer -
- (a) electricity,
 - (b) gas,

- (c) oil,
 - (d) water and drainage.
6. The accommodation, facilities, equipment and services -
- (a) must be provided free of any charge or fee, and
 - (b) may be the same accommodation, facilities, equipment and services provided to the Committee for the purposes of customs and excise controls, unless otherwise directed by a senior immigration officer.

Specified Accommodation

7. The following premises are specified accommodation for the purposes of this Schedule, except where a variation or an alternative is agreed in writing with a senior immigration officer.

7.1 Guernsey Airport

At Guernsey Airport, premises in the main Airport building used as the following at the date on which this Order is made -

- (a) General Immigration and Customs Office (including parking provision),
- (b) Immigration and Customs CCTV room,
- (c) Immigration and Customs Detention Suite,
- (d) Immigration Control Point,
- (e) Immigration and Customs Search Area (including private search room),
- (f) Immigration and Customs Equipment Store.

7.2 St. Peter Port Harbour

At St. Peter Port Harbour, premises used as the following at the date on which this Order is made –

- (a) General Immigration and Customs Office (including parking provision),
- (b) Vehicle Immigration Control Point,
- (c) Harbour Terminal Immigration Control Point,
- (d) Harbour Terminal Immigration and Customs Search Area (including private search room),
- (e) Immigration and Customs Equipment store.

7.3 Alderney Airport

At Alderney Airport, premises in the main Airport building used as the following at the date on which this Order is made -

- (a) General Immigration and Customs Office (including parking provision),
- (b) Immigration Control Point,
- (c) Immigration and Customs Search Area (including private search room).

7.4 Braye Harbour, Alderney

At Braye Harbour, Alderney, premises used as the following at the date on which this Order is made -

- (a) Immigration and Customs Office (including parking provision),

- (b) Immigration Control Point,
- (c) Immigration and Customs Search Area (including private search room).

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order prescribes the accommodation, facilities, equipment and services that must be provided by the person responsible for the management of a control port for, or in connection with, the operation of immigration control.

This Order comes into force on the 19th September, 2025.
