**The Waste Management Services (Charging)  
Regulations, 2025**

**THE WASTE DISPOSAL AUTHORITY<sup>a</sup>**, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by sections 1 and 3 of the Waste Management Services (Charging) Ordinance, 2018<sup>b</sup> and all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations:-

**Amendment of the Waste Management Services (Charging) Ordinance, 2018.**

1. The Schedule to the Waste Management Services (Charging) Ordinance, 2018 is amended as follows -

- (a) in Table A of Part I -
  - (i) for "£1.88" substitute "£2.04", and

- (ii) for "£3.38" substitute "£3.67",
- (b) in Table B of Part I -
  - (i) for "£1.88" substitute "£2.04", and
  - (ii) for "£3.38" substitute "£3.67", and
- (c) in Part II, for "£112.97" substitute "£123.00".

**Revocation.**

2. The Waste Management Services (Charging) Regulations, 2024<sup>c</sup> are revoked.

**Citation and commencement.**

3. These Regulations may be cited as the Waste Management Services (Charging) Regulations, 2025 and shall come into force on the 1<sup>st</sup> January, 2026.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This note is not part of the Regulations)*

These Regulations amend the Schedule to the Waste Management Services (Charging) Ordinance, 2018 to increase the prescribed bag charges for residual waste bags of both sizes (up to and including 50 litres in capacity and those 51 to 90 litres in capacity) and the annual fixed charge for waste management services provided by the Waste Disposal Authority by RPIx as at the end of June, 2025 and by an additional 5%.

These charges have previously been increased in line with the resolutions made by the States of Deliberation at their meeting on 8<sup>th</sup> September 2022 (Resolutions 4 and 5 of Article IV of Billet d'Etat No. XIII of 2022). These resolutions stipulated that the household waste charges should be increased annually by no more than an annual increase of RPIx plus 1% (capped at 5%) to the "pay as you throw" bag charge for general waste and by no more than an increase of RPIx plus 1% (capped at £5) per year to the Waste Disposal Authority's annual waste charge. These resolutions were valid until the end of 2025. The Waste Disposal Authority are now increasing these charges by RPIx plus 5% (and, for the fees relating to the annual fixed charge, these have been rounded up to the nearest pound), with the intention of recovering increased revenue to contribute towards the costs reasonably incurred by the States in providing household waste management services and thereby reducing the potential contribution requiring to be made to cover these costs by general revenue.

These Regulations come into force on the 1<sup>st</sup> January, 2026.
