**The Traffic Temporary (Ruelle des Delisles)
Regulations, 2025**

Made

3rd November, 2025

Coming into operation

1st December, 2025

THE COMMITTEE FOR THE ENVIRONMENT & INFRASTRUCTURE, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section 1 of the Traffic Temporary Regulations Ordinance, 1950^a and all other powers enabling it in that behalf, and in order to ascertain the best method of regulating traffic in the locality referred to in these Regulations, hereby makes the following Regulations:-

Prohibition relating to traffic on Ruelle des Delisles.

1. (1) Subject to paragraphs (2) and (3), a person in charge of a power-driven vehicle shall not drive or ride that vehicle on or along that part of Ruelle des Delisles (in the parish of Castel) between a traffic sign of the type numbered 49 in Schedule 2 of the Traffic Signs and Traffic Light Signals Ordinance, 1988^b and a traffic sign of the type numbered 42 in Schedule 2 of that Ordinance.

(2) Paragraph (1) applies only from 8:00 a.m. to 8:30 a.m. and from 3:00 p.m. to 3:30 p.m. on days that Les Beaucamps High School is open to pupils in accordance with the determinations of the Committee for Education, Sport & Culture under section 8 of the Education (Guernsey) Law, 1970^c, or in accordance with any similar power under any other enactment.

(3) Paragraph (1) does not apply to –

- (a) an electrically assisted pedal cycle (within the meaning of section 3 of the Motor Vehicles (Electrically Assisted Pedal Cycles) (Exemption) (Guernsey) Law, 2002^d),
- (b) a vehicle being used for ambulance, fire brigade or police purposes in an emergency,
- (c) anything done with the permission of, or at the direction of, a member of the salaried police force of the Island of Guernsey or, within the limits of their jurisdiction, a member of the special constabulary of the Island of Guernsey, or
- (d) anything done in accordance with the terms of any permission given under the authority of the Committee for the Environment & Infrastructure.

Extent.

2. These Regulations shall have effect in the Island of Guernsey.

Citation.

3. These Regulations may be cited as the Traffic Temporary (Ruelle des Delisles) Regulations, 2025.

Commencement.

4. These Regulations shall come into force on 1st December 2025 and cease to have effect –

- (a) at the end of the period of 12 months commencing with that date, or
- (b) on any earlier date determined by further regulations made by the Committee for the Environment & Infrastructure.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations make provision for the introduction, for an experimental period of up to 12 months, of a prohibition on driving or riding a power-driven vehicle on Ruelle des Delisles during specified times. The purpose is to ascertain the best method of regulating traffic in close proximity to Les Beaucamps High School on school days, at times when pupils typically arrive at or leave the school, with a view to ensuring the safety of pedestrians and cyclists and encouraging the adoption of active transportation methods.

The prohibition does not apply to electrically assisted pedal cycles or emergency vehicles. It also does not apply to anything done in accordance with permission given by the Committee for the Environment & Infrastructure or at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police officer.
