The Boarding Permit Fees Order, 2026

Made

13th January, 2026

Coming into operation

1st April, 2026

Laid before the States

THE COMMITTEE FOR ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 17 of the Tourist Law, 1948^a and all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby orders:-

Fee payable by applicants for a boarding permit.

1. An applicant for a boarding permit shall pay to the Committee on application for a permit valid from 1st April 2026 to 31st March 2027, or part thereof, the following fee -

- a) for an application in respect of accommodation to be provided in premises which would be categorised as a hotel, guest accommodation, serviced apartment or self-catering premises were a boarding permit to be granted under the Law, the sum of £11.50 per person inscribed on each application submitted, or

- b) for an application in respect of accommodation to be provided in premises of any description not falling within subparagraph (a), the sum of £68.00 per permit application submitted.

Interpretation.

2. In this Order, unless the context requires otherwise the “**Committee**” means the Committee for Economic Development.

Revocation.

3. The Boarding Permit Fees Order, 2025^b is revoked.

Citation.

4. This Order may be cited as the Boarding Permit Fees Order, 2026.

Commencement.

5. This Order comes into force on the 1st April, 2026.
