

# **The Firearms (Sark) Law, 2001**

## **(Commencement and Fees) Ordinance, 2002**

**THE CHIEF PLEAS OF SARK**, in pursuance of their Resolution of 2<sup>nd</sup> October, 2002, and in exercise of the powers conferred on them by sections 54 and 60(2) of the Firearms (Sark) Law, 2001<sup>a</sup>, hereby order:

### **Commencement.**

1. The Firearms (Sark) Law, 2001 shall come into force on 1<sup>st</sup> January 2003.

### **Fees.**

2. (1) The prescribed fee under section 34 of the Firearms (Sark) Law, 2001 -

- (a) on the grant of a firearm or shotgun certificate;
- (b) on the renewal of any such certificate or on the replacement of any such certificate, which has been lost or destroyed; and
- (c) on any variation of any such certificate (otherwise than when it is renewed or replaced at the same time);

shall be £5.

(2) The prescribed fee under section 37 of the Firearms (Sark) Law, 2001 at the time of registration or re-registration as a firearms dealer shall be

**Period of validity of licences.**

3. Firearms and shotgun licences issued under the terms of the Firearms (Sark) Law, 2001 shall cease to be valid on the 31<sup>st</sup> December following the date of issue of the licence.

**Citation.**

4. This Ordinance may be cited as the Firearms (Sark) Law, 2001 (Commencement and Fees) Ordinance, 2002.
